Minutes

Water Department Report

Fire Department

The Arnoldsville Fire Chief, Heath Baker said that everything was going well. There have been a couple of calls. One fireman will take the state test on Saturday.

Chief Baker stated that they will be in the building by the middle or the end of next month. The fire department will be at Grove Chapel Church on June 27th for fireworks.

Zoning

Land Use/Zoning Officer Lynn Shedd was not present.

New Business

Mayor Danny Morcom told the council that he called about a 12 x 15 plaque for the former mayors of the City of Arnoldsville that has (12) name plates and a place for the years served. Old Business

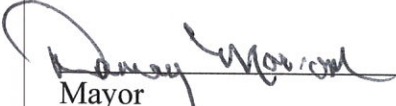
City Attorney Danny Love said that we needed to amend the three levels of penalties.

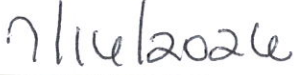
