7:00 p.m. Meeting called to order.

The minutes for the regular monthly meeting held on September 15, 2015 were read and approved as submitted on a motion from Norma Craddock with a second from George Spearing, IV. Vote 4 – 0

The financial report presented for the month of September for the city's General Fund account was approved on a motion from Joyce Sniff with a second from Lee Norman. Vote 4 – 0

The financial report presented for the month of September for the city's Water Fund account was approved on a motion from George Spearing, IV with a second from Joyce Sniff. Vote 4 – 0

Water

Water Superintendent, George Spearing, reported that everything was running fine with the water system. He also reported that the EPD had "finally" taken the well located on Meyer Farm Rd. offline. This is the well that had been producing poorly for some time.

Mayor Banks mentioned to the council that it was time to make a decision regarding the water tank maintenance contract for the tank located at 154 Yancey Rd. next to the city hall building. The notice to terminate the current contract with Utility Services is due by November 15, 2015. On a motion from Joyce Sniff with a second from Norma Craddock, the council voted to terminate the current tank maintenance contract with Utility Services Co. for the tank at 154 Yancey Rd. The motion also included the plan of contracting with TankPro for maintenance on this tank. Vote 4 - 0

Fire Department

No one was available to give any report on the fire department for this month.

Other Business

Mayor Banks reported that the repairs to stop the leaking of the building had been completed by Stanley Holmes. The total billed for the work and materials was \$470.00 which came under the estimate that was originally submitted. Mr. Holmes had also suggested that the city purchase a dehumidifier for the building and install awnings on the front to prevent rain from blowing into the windows. Mayor Banks will check on the cost of getting these suggestions taken care of and present that information at the next meeting in November.

Jack Norman asked if the council was planning the annual holiday supper again this year. On a motion from Joyce Sniff with a second from Norma Craddock, it was decided that the Holiday Party would be held at the Arnoldsville Baptist Church on Saturday, December 5 beginning at 6:00 p.m. The city clerk will include invitations in the water bills. It was mentioned that a special effort would be made to invite the Fire Department. Vote 5 - 0
