Minutes

On a motion by Lee Norman, seconded by Jack Norman, the minutes for the December 15, 2016 meeting were approved as submitted. 5 - 0

General Fund Financials

On a motion by Jack Norman seconded by Danny Morcom, the December General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 5-0

Water

Water Superintendent George Spearing, III reported that there had been an issue with the computer losing memory in relation to the well. This is being corrected.

Water Fund Financials

On a motion by Danny Morcom seconded by Norma Craddock, the December Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 5-0

Fire Department

The fire department was represented by Mr. Melvin Fleming who reported that all is quiet at this time. He reported that there had been good attendance at the last meeting with no new members.

Other Business

Jenna Kettenring Hazelet of ServLine was present to give information on water leak insurance that is available for water customers. Ms. Hazelet presented good information describing the program and the approximate cost and benefits of the program. It was decided that the city clerk and water superintendent would prepare information regarding how many times approximately

that the city had experienced leak issues with water customers. Once this information is gathered, Ms. Hazelet will be notified so she can give a more exact figure on what could be charged customers if the city does make the decision to implement this program.

Zoning

After a brief discussion regarding one addition to the section 4-3-1 on bicycle lanes, Council member Danny Morcom made the motion to include the additional language with a second from Jack Norman. Vote 5 – 0

On a motion from Greg Banks with a second from Danny Morcom, the council then voted to hear the first reading of the zoning ordinance on the condition that City Attorney Love dispense with the reading of the whole ordinance. He will just read the Preamble. Vote 5 – 0

On a motion from Danny Morcom with a second from Lee Norman, the council voted to adopt the first reading of the zoning ordinance. The vote was 4 yes with one abstaining.

Next on the agenda was the subject of the City Survey and the property located around the city hall area. After a brief discussion, it was decided that the surveying issue would be tabled at this time.


