Minutes

General Fund Financial Report

Water Fund Financial Report

On a motion from Blake Arnold, seconded by Lillian Sanders, the September 2025 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 3-0

Water Department Report

Water Superintendent, Adam Boswell, said that everything was running smoothly right now. He said he took the last two water samples to UGA, and both came back great.

Mayor Danny Morcom said that a paving company had opened one of the fire hydrants at full blast and caused some water pressure issues. Adam Boswell called them, and they fixed the problem. Fire Hydrants were flushed to clear it up.

Mr. Boswell stated that EPD would be here on Monday for the new well.

Fire Department

The Arnoldsville Fire Chief, Heath Baker, said they were almost at as many calls as they were all last year. There have been mainly wrecks and grass fires.

Next Saturday, October 25th is the BBQ and 50/50 raffle. Also, they lost 2 members but gained (1) fully trained member. Douglas Cosby will be certified next week.

Zoning

Land Use/Zoning Officer Lynn Shedd reported that he checked one for an electrical permit where a meter was pulled with Rayle EMC. He also said that the people on Yancey Road still have not cut their grass.

New Business

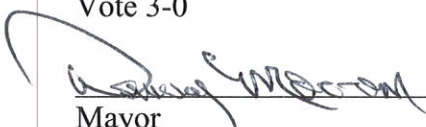
