This public hearing was held for the purpose of the Annexation and Rezoning of property located at 436 Yancey Rd., belonging to the Arnoldsville Fire Department and 439 Yancey Rd., owned by William Curtis Fleming. These properties were previously zoned under Oglethorpe County Zoning.

Signatures were obtained from the property owners on March 8 and March 14, 2019 requesting permission to be annexed into the City Limits of Arnoldsville and rezoned. Oglethorpe County received notice on March 19, 2019 with a newspaper ad being run on April 4, 2019 concerning the re-zoning and public meeting. The notice of rezoning sign was installed on both properties on April 13, 2019.

6:30 PM – Public Hearing Closed/ Planning Commission Meeting Open


The Chairman of the Planning Commission, George L. Spearing, IV, read the recommendation prepared by the Planning Commission and called for a vote. The recommendation was as follows:
