Minutes

On a motion by Jack Norman, seconded by Lee Norman, the minutes for the October 18, 2018 meeting were approved as submitted. 5 – 0

General Fund Financials

On a motion by Norma Craddock seconded by Danny Morcom, the October 2018 General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 5 - 0

Water

Water Superintendent George L. Spearing, III reported that everything is fine with the water system with no current problems.

Water Fund Financials

On a motion from Lee Norman with a second from Jack Norman, the October 2018 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 5 - 0

Fire Department

Fire Chief, Heath Baker reported that everything is running smoothly. He reported that the bar-b-q was a success. The new radios they ordered are expected to be delivered tomorrow (11/16/18). The new gear ordered minus the pants and coats has all come in.

Code Enforcement/Zoning

Code Enforcement Officer Lynn Shedd reported that he had an inquiry regarding the possibility of removing an old trailer and replacing it with a new one. Shedd explained the zoning process but has not heard anything further.

Annexation Research

City Attorney Love provided information received back from the surveyor regarding his ongoing annexation research. He stated that the survey received is accurate regarding City Limits. The next step will be for the Mayor to speak with any property owners that would be affected.

City Hall Building Maintenance

It has been determined that the roof of the current city hall building is in need of cool sealing. Mayor Spearing reported that Lynn Shedd would be available to complete the sealing and do the pressure washing of the building as well. Council member Danny Morcom offered his personal pressure washer to be used for this project. Council member Greg Banks made a motion for the mayor to use his discretion on the quote from Shedd to do this work. The motion was seconded by Norma Craddock. Vote 5 - 0

Other Business

Because the regular December meeting falls on December 20th, Mayor Spearing asked about moving the meeting to an earlier date. After a brief discussion, Greg Banks made a motion that the December meeting be cancelled with the understanding that if anything came up that needed handling, a called meeting would be scheduled. This motion was seconded by Norma Craddock. Vote 5 - 0

City Clerk Debbie Love provided the cost of two new flags, one U.S. Flag and one State Flag at \$57.00 apiece for flags sized at 4' x 6'. Jack Norman made a motion that the flags be purchased at this size and price with a second from Danny Morcom. Vote 5 - 0

Mayor Spearing reported that he had been checking with Georgia Power regarding what would be involved with placing flags and possibly Christmas decorations on certain power poles located inside the city limits. He has had no success so far in this process. He will continue to investigate this issue.
