Water Department Report

Water Superintendent, George Spearing, III reported that the maintenance for the tank located at City Hall had been recently completed. He also reported that a fire hydrant located on Dunlap Rd. had been broken off and he will be making that repair. Spearing stated that he is still waiting for additional information regarding a filtration system but is also looking into other companies that specialize in filtration systems. One new tap will be installed next week.

●Water Ordinance Revisions/Updates

Vote 5-0 City Attorney Love gave the second reading for the updated water ordinance. On a motion from Danny Morcom and a second from Jack Norman, the ordinance passed. Vote 5-0

The 2022 Proposed Budget was presented by the Budget Committee, Norma Craddock, Danny Morcom and Mayor Spearing. On a motion from Danny Sniff and a second from Danny Morcom, the 2022 Budget was adopted. Vote 5 - 0

●LIHWAP Water Supplemental Agreement

On a motion from Norma Craddock with a second from Jack Norman, the council voted to go into the contract regarding assistance for low income water customers. This program is being provided through DFCS. Vote 5-0

● **Holiday Flags**

Mr. Morcom will handle the ordering of new replacement flags. He will replace the heavier flags with nylon flags that will hopefully hold up better. Motion was made by Jack Norman with a second from Norma Craddock. Vote 5-0 (approved)
