Application for Water - Existing Service - Residential

The City of Arnoldsville requires a completed application and **non-refundable Application Fee of \$125.00** for transferring an **existing** service into the name of a new resident.

Completed applications including fee payment may be submitted in one of the following ways:

1. Mail to: City of Arnoldsville, P.O. Box 2, 154 Yancey Rd., Arnoldsville, GA 30619
2. Bring your completed application and fee to City Hall or use the drop-box located between the U.S. Post Office & Arnoldsville City Hall, address 154 Yancey Rd., Arnoldsville, GA 30619. If you choose to bring payment to the drop-box, please make sure you place it in the **black, padlocked/slotted** side of the box. Mail is pulled from this box every day. **Please do not place any money in the lift-up, white side of the drop-box. It is not locked.**

Arnoldsville offers the following monthly payment options once service is established:

1) U.S. Mail; 2) City Drop-Box; 3) ACH Online Bank Draft; 4) Online Bill Pay. **Please indicate in the box provided on the Application** if you would like to pay via ACH. The required ACH form for this payment option is attached. The Online Bill Pay option is available on the home page of this website. Instructions for online payment are included with this package.

Arnoldsville also offers e-billing. If you prefer to receive your bill via email, **please indicate in the box provided on the Application** making sure you list your email address. It is always helpful to provide your email address even if you prefer a mailed bill.

A Water Loss Protection Plan at the cost of an additional \$1.00 per month is available. **Please indicate in the box provided on the Application** if you would like to participate in the program. A copy of the plan is attached.
