Minutes

On motion by Councilman Jack Norman, seconded by Lee Norman the minutes for the April 21, 2016 meeting were approved as submitted. 3-0

General Fund Financials

On a motion by Norma Craddock seconded by Lee Norman the April General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 3-0.

Water

Water Superintendent, George Spearing, III reported that all wells are running good with no problems at this time. He mentioned that several new connections had been installed with more coming.

City Clerk, Debbie Love, mentioned that the "reminders" for water customers regarding damages to water meters during grass-cutting season will go out with the next billing cycle. Fees will be charged accordingly as follows:

Lid - \$25
Box - \$50

Water Fund Financials

Fire Department

Mr. Melvin Fleming reported that all is well with the fire department at this time.

Mutual Aid

Douglas Spencer was present to follow-up with the city regarding their position on the Mutual Aid Program sponsored by Oglethorpe County. He reported that Crawford and Maxeys have both completed all paperwork. Lexington has not. City Attorney Love suggested that after his research, he saw no reason that Arnoldsville should not enter into the agreement.

Mr. Spencer also asked for a representative from the city council for the quarterly meetings of the Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee. These meetings will be held at the county EMS Station. This committee will be discussing the Emergency Operations Plan for the county and should be finished up by December. Council member Jack Norman will be available as well as Greg Banks. Banks will sign the letter agreeing to this plan.

Mr. Spencer reported that the status of the repeaters is that they are currently retesting and still in progress.

Zoning

Mayor Pro Tem Banks stated that the city should refocus their attention to zoning once the new mayor comes in.

Other Business

A short discussion was held regarding the upcoming appointment of a new council member.

Jack Norman mentioned that the trees that had been in question on the adjoining property of the city had been taken down.

The subject of the floor repair of the city hall was discussed with it being decided that Norma Craddock will contact Mike Eidson regarding the status of this repair.
