Minutes

On a motion by Lee Norman, seconded by Danny Morcom, the minutes for the March 15, 2018 meeting were approved as submitted. 5 – 0

Executive Session Minutes

On a motion by Danny Morcom seconded by Lee Norman, the minutes for the Executive Session held on March 15, 2018 were approved as submitted. 5-0

General Fund Financials

On a motion by Norma Craddock seconded by Lee Norman, the March 2018 General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 5 - 0

Water

Water Superintendent, George L. Spearing, III reported that all was good with the wells etc. All pumps are working great right now. New taps are being added with two new houses under construction.

Mayor Spearing reported that he and the Mayor of Crawford had signed the agreement between Arnoldsville, Crawford, Lexington and Maxeys regarding the Emergency Water Rates. They signed this agreement on April 5, 2018.

Water Fund Financials

On a motion from Jack Norman with a second from Greg Banks, the March 2018 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 5 - 0

Fire Department

Keith Hardman reported that the fire department had responded to a house fire recently and several automobile fires. They will have a hose pressure testing coming up in the next week. He also reported that the fund raiser went well. The fire department was recently recognized by the Woodmen of the World. A new Rescue Truck is also being acquired for this area.

Douglas Spencer was present to discuss the possibility of storing a 15 kilowatt generator somewhere on the property of the Arnoldsville City Hall. This is a piece of equipment that would be used in the event of a catastrophic situation. It can be moved wherever it is needed. This equipment is currently on a trailer that is 14' x 18' in size. After some discussion, it was decided that Mayor Spearing will take a look at the equipment and make a decision about where or if this request can be accommodated.

Code Enforcement/Zoning

Lynn Shedd reported he had issued permits recently for two new homes being built inside the city limits.

Other Business

Mayor Spearing informed the council that the city will receive approximately \$3,600.77 in LMIG funds for the upcoming year. He asked for suggestions and ideas from the council for possible projects. The city will be required to provide an additional 30% of this funding which would come to approximately \$1,080.00 to complete a project.

On a motion from Greg Banks with a second from Norma Craddock, the council voted to approve the bill presented by City Attorney Danny Love for his March Litigation expenses pertaining to Railroad Street. Vote 5-0
