At 6:00 pm Mayor Danny Morcom called the meeting to order. He recognized City Attorney, Danny Love, for his 25 years of service.

Minutes

On a motion from Joyce Sniff, seconded by Douglas Cosby, the minutes for the August 21, 2025, public meeting was approved as submitted. Vote 4-0

On a motion from Douglas Cosby, seconded by Lillian Sanders, the minutes for the August 21, 2025, regular meeting was approved as submitted. Vote 4-0

General Fund Financial Report

On a motion from Douglas Cosby, seconded by Joyce Sniff, the August 2025 General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 4-0

Water Fund Financial Report

On a motion from Lillian Sanders, seconded by Douglas Cosby, the August 2025 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 4-0

Water Department Report

Water Superintendent, Adam Boswell, was not present. Land Use/Zoning Officer Lynn Shedd said that he spoke with Adam and that everything was running well. Mr. Shedd said that Adam was on crutches and is wearing a boot. Mayor Morcom said that Adam had surgery on his foot and has been out for three weeks.

Lynn Shedd explained that the permit for the new well had been sent in, but they had not gotten anything back yet.

Fire Department

The Arnoldsville Fire Chief, Heath Baker, was not present. Douglas Cosby said there had been 108 calls from the first of the year until the end of August. He said there were (2) accidents last week on Hwy. 78 and a car fire off Dawson Rd.

The Barbecue is October 25th. The prices will be the same as last year. They will be doing the 50/50 raffle. It will be at the fire station starting around 9 or 10 am.

Also, they gained one new fireman, and one came back. There are about 20 on the roster. They are still waiting for quotes for the building.

Zoning

Land Use/Zoning Officer Lynn Shedd reported that he gave a homeowner 15 days to get their grass cut.

New Business

Mayor, Danny Morcom, asked the council for volunteers to help with the 2026 Budget. Council member, Joyce Sniff, said that she would be happy to help. Mayor Morcom said that it needed to be done before the October meeting.

City Attorney, Danny Love, asked the mayor and council to look at the ordinance book again because it had not been updated since 2008.

Old Business

Mayor Morcom said that he received (3) quotes for the paving of the City Hall parking lot. The quotes were \$25,300.00, \$25,708.00, and \$21,480.00. On a motion from Joyce Sniff, seconded by Douglas Cosby, it was approved to use the lowest bidder for the paving of the City Hall parking lot. Vote 4-0

Lynn Shedd presented the mayor and the council with an estimate for the upgrade of the water system on Pine Grove Road. City Attorney, Danny Love, said that legally the council needs to get three quotes. On a motion from Douglas Cosby, seconded by Lillian Sanders, it was approved to get (2) other quotes for the upgrade of the water system at Pine Grove Road. Vote 4-0
