Minutes

On a motion by Danny Morcom, seconded by Norma Craddock, the minutes for the February 15, 2018 meeting were approved as submitted. 5 - 0

General Fund Financials

On a motion by Norma Craddock seconded by Greg Banks, the February 2018 General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. 5 - 0

Water

Water Superintendent, George L. Spearing, III reported that there had been no breaks in the past month. He has had to replace several failed meters. Spearing reported that the current chemical feed pumps need to be replaced. He submitted an estimate to replace four pumps at \$395.00 each. On a motion made by Greg Banks with a second from Norma Craddock, the council voted that Spearing purchase the least expensive chemical pumps at a cost of no more than \$395.00 each. Vote 5 - 0

Mayor Spearing reported that the Emergency Rates as suggested by the Crawford Council had been approved at \$5.00/1000 gallons. He stated that a letter was forthcoming from the Mayor of Crawford.

Water Fund Financials

On a motion from Jack Norman with a second from Danny Morcom, the February 2018 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 5 - 0

Fire Department

Fire Chief, Heath Baker was present to report on the fire department. He reminded the council about the upcoming Chicken Mull fund raiser that is to be held at the fire hall on March 24. He stated that there would also be raffle tickets for sale at \$10 each with the proceeds going toward the 2019 insurance fund. He also stated that he had applied for four (4) free turnout gears through Georgia Pacific. This is a grant for volunteer fire departments. This would be for out of date turnout gear.

Code Enforcement/Zoning

Lynn Shedd reported he had issued several permits recently. He will also issue a citation for yard clean up at the corner of Yancey Rd. and Winterville Rd. This area has has been previously cited with some success. The yard is becoming un-sitely again.

Other Business

At this time, Mayor Spearing inquired about any questions/discussion from the audience. Mr. Seagraves inquired about the possibility of a citation being issued at the corner of Yancey and Meyer Farm Rd. due to couches being out in the yard.

City Attorney Love reported that the surveyor had finished the maps and filed them. He mentioned that the city may think about having a possible recombination on city deeds completed in the future.
