## Minutes

## General Fund Financial Report

On a motion from Danny Sniff seconded by Danny Morcom, the August General Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 5-0

## Water Department Report

Water Superintendent, George L. Spearing, III reported that he had been working with Dan Elder regarding a filtration system for the well house located at White's Run. This is currently the well with the highest concentration of iron. Mayor Spearing pointed out that it is important to keep the equipment inside the well house. Spearing #3 also reported that he is in the process of getting an electrician to make improvements to Well #4 located on Meyer Farm to get it back online.

## Water Fund Financial Report

On a motion from Danny Morcom with a second from Danny Sniff, the August 2021 Water Fund Financial Report was approved as submitted. Vote 5-0

## Fire Department

Norma Craddock, Treasurer for the fire department reminded the council about the upcoming Bar-B-Q on October 30, 2021.

## **Code Enforcement**

Land Use/Zoning Officer, Lynn Shedd reported that he had spoken with City Attorney Love regarding specific wording for a Resolution and Permit for future Solar Permits within the city limits. Mr. Shedd and City Attorney Love will come up with an ordinance and wording regarding a solar panel hybrid permit.

## **Old Business**

### **●City Hall Marker**

Council member Danny Sniff provided four different ideas/designs of a City Hall Marker for the council to review and consider. After some discussion, it was decided that now Sniff can combine the design of two of the examples given and get some pricing.

### **●Implementation Plan/STWP**

Next the council discussed several suggestions provided that could be included on the Short Term Work Plan that is to be submitted by October 31, 2021. The following items are to be listed on the plan for 2018 - 2022: Flashing Speed Limit Signs, Water System Improvements, LMIG Crosswalks, and Paving the City Hall Parking Lot. This discussion and decision was counted as the first Public Hearing that is required to adopt this plan. The next Public Hearing will take place on October 21, 2021 during the regularly scheduled meeting.

### **●Water Ordinance Revisions/Updates**

On a motion from Norma Craddock with a second from Danny Sniff, the council voted to dispense with the reading of the entire Water Ordinance. City Attorney Love gave the required information for the first reading of the revised Water Ordinance. The second reading will held at the next meeting.

### **●City Hall Cleaning**

After a brief discussion regarding the cleaning of the city hall building, Tracy Massey made a motion to table the pursuing of someone to clean the building. Once a new city clerk is hired, that person will be offered extra compensation for the responsibility of cleaning City Hall. The motion was seconded by Norma Craddock. Vote 5-0
